EDITOR's COMMENT

Ref: 1974 UFO Recovery within the City of Carbondale, PA

My impression is things went on which, perhaps, and I emphasize, **perhaps**, people still can't or won't talk about. Going by appearance and legend, something landed and was later picked up. Something unique and unusual happened. There is no reason to believe anyone acted in anything other than an honorable manner under difficult and unusual circumstances.

There's too many stories over the past half-century concerning the landing or crashing of these discs for them to all be nonsense. Each such story deserves its day in public discussion and reportage.

Often, as with Roswell, New Mexico, public discussion begins, effectively, years later. All sides and aspects to a story matters. Open and free discussion will eventually result in whatever the truth or lack of truth of any given story is.

In many of these events concerning discs, or UFOs, those in public service have borne the brunt of the mystery involved. When something unknown is discovered, the authorities are eventually notified, as was the case in Roswell.

Invariably, they have done the best they could. They should never be made out to be bugbears. When confronted by something as unusual as a crashed or landed disc which couldn't be readily identified, no one would know exactly what to do.

An interesting item of the presence of some of these discs is the extreme effect they sometimes have upon people. Extreme fear is one. And there may be other effects upon people near them which we are not aware of.

During the course of some of these recoveries, it appears common, everyday people and local authorities were charged with keeping secrets by higher authority.

They did so, like it or not, and went on about their jobs and lives as loyal citizens.

There's nothing local authorities can do when people from higher authority arrives on the scene and takes over a given situation. The locals can only do what looks right at the moment. Many of them have spent their lives in their localities. They see themselves as part of the area, not overlords of the local people. When the high-ups move in, the local authorities move back. Local authorities are placed between a rock and a hard place.

They are duty bound both to local people and higher authority. By 1974 the cold war had flourished for thirty years. By that time the hot wars had claimed over a hundred thousand Americans. It had bred a genuine need for security and secret keeping.

News of such an unidentified disc being discovered would certainly have been something high authorities would want to keep out of the international press. It seems to take about forty-fifty years for some of these things to get mentioned.

Roswell took its time. Small circulation newsletters, sometimes called, "*crank papers*," kept an eye on the item, kept reporting more about it until it's now known by many. The people near Roswell knew for decades that "*something*" had happened; they didn't know exactly what though.

The actions taken during such events are always easy to criticize later. No one could be expected to act in perfect manner during such a unique event. The requirement of maintaining regular functions of public service continues during any such event. It's only one item on the agenda.

Very few in local governments attempt to abuse citizens or use them as dupes. In none of the alleged crash areas have the local authorities used people as dupes. If there is a World Supra Government which influences national governments as some of us believe, such a government would probably be one for people not to trust.

Few would know what its goal was. The possible existence of such a super government has been routinely laughed at for years. But slowly, as information is assembled, it appears there is some sort of overseer of the worlds national governments.
